Alease take the feather

.... and hold it on the palm of your hand.

Can you feel it? Most people can't.

Now hold it against your cheek. Can you feel it now?

Parts of us are more sensitive than others to the light touch of the feather.

The touch of the spirit is often very light, too. Sensitivity to that light touch is not something we seem very good at teaching the average person in the pew. Perhaps that is why today's spiritual seekers find little they can connect with in church.
